

SUBJECT: Mandatory Privately Owned Weapons Registration Requirements

Reference: Air Force Instruction 31-101, 18 October 2011, Incorporating Change 2,
7 March 2013, *Integrated Defense*

1. AFI 31-101, *Integrated Defense*, para. 8.4.2.4.1.1, states "Registration of privately owned firearms is mandatory when stored on the installation. This includes weapons stored in family/privatized housing and the armory.
2. The following procedures will be followed based on category:
 - a. Military – An AF Form 1314, *Firearms Registration* must be completed by the member and signed by their commander. Commanders geographically separated from their members are still required to sign the AF Form 1314.
 - b. Civilian – An AF Form 1314, *Firearms Registration* must be completed and signed by the resident. Civilians include, military retirees, civil service employees and civilians with no other military affiliation should the Waterfall open to them.
3. AF Form 1314s can be obtained by contacting your unit command section or by calling the Security Forces Pass & Registration office at 987-6338. Weapons registration requirements must be completed by each resident wishing to store weapons in their privatized family home within 14 calendar days of signing a lease.
4. We enjoy a thriving and safe residential community. Our goal is to make our community as safe as possible for everyone residing in our privatized housing area. Thank you for your cooperation in this endeavor.
5. This memorandum becomes void after one-year has elapsed from the date above.
