SUBJECT: Assessment of the Effectiveness of the Department of Defense Prisoner of War/Missing in Action Accounting Community (Project No. D2014-D00SPO-0073)

The objective is to assess the Department's programs and practices concerning the identification and repatriation of the remains of the Nation's missing-in-action from past armed conflicts. This will include the overall accounting community organization and waste, abuse, mismanagement, travel issues, and other deficiencies related to the administration of programs carried out by the Defense POW/Missing Personnel Office (DPMO), Joint POW-MIA Accounting Command (JPAC), and other members of the accounting community.

This assessment is being conducted at the request of the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, members of the Senate Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs Committee, and the House Armed Services Committee. We plan to use all pertinent information collected as a result of our research conducted during project D2013-D000SPO-0219, "Research Assessment on the Department's Programs to Identify and Repatriate the Remains of the Nation's Missing Fallen from Past Armed Conflicts."

We plan to begin this assessment immediately.

We intend to contact and visit DoD organizations associated with this mission, including, but not limited to, DPMO, JPAC, the Under Secretary of Defense for Policy, the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness, the U.S. Pacific Command, the Armed Forces DNA Identification Laboratory, and the Service Casualty Assistance Offices. Others organizations or personnel may be identified during the assessment.
