SUBJECT: Reannouncement of the Audit of the V-22 Osprey's Mission Readiness Rates, Maintainability, and Sustainment Cost (Project No. D2011-D000LH-0170.000)

We are reannouncing the subject audit, announced June 2011 (see attachment), to inform you of changes in our scope; we have expanded our audit scope to include FY 2011. The original audit objective was to evaluate whether the V-22 Osprey's performance is meeting the mission capability rate requirements. Specifically, we will evaluate how the frequency of repairs and the replacement of supply parts affected the V-22's mission readiness from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2010. Under this announcement, we will evaluate how the frequency of repairs and the replacement of supply parts affected the V-22's mission readiness from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2011.

We will perform the audit at the Patuxent River Naval Air Station, Maryland; Marine Corps Air Station New River, Jacksonville, North Carolina; and Air Force Special Operation Command, Hurlburt Field, Florida; Allison Engine Company, Indianapolis, Indiana; and Bell Helicopter Textron Incorporated, Fort Worth, Texas. We may identify additional locations during the audit.
