SUBJECT: Audit of Pricing and Oversight of the Kuwait Observer Controller Team Task Orders (Project No. D2011-D000AS-0287.000)

We plan to begin the subject audit in September 2011. This audit will be the third in a series of audits relating to the Warfighter Field Operations Customer Support contract. Our audit objectives are to determine whether the U.S. Army Program Executive Office for Simulation, Training, and Instrumentation obtained fair and reasonable prices for goods and services on the Kuwait Observer Controller Team task orders and appropriately developed contractor surveillance and oversight processes and procedures for the task orders. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at the U.S. Army Program Executive Office for Simulation, Training, and Instrumentation, Orlando, Florida; Defense Contract Audit Agency, Dulles, Virginia; and Defense Contract Management Agency, Dulles, Virginia. We may identify additional locations during the audit. We intend to use previously provided points of contact from each location.
