SUBJECT: Review of Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) Collection Requirements for Criminal Investigations (Project No. 2012C018)

The Office of the Inspector General is initiating a review to evaluate compliance with the DNA collection requirements in DoDI 5505.14, "Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) Collection Requirements for Criminal Investigations," as amended April 24, 2012. We will focus on whether:

- DNA was collected from Service Members convicted of qualifying offenses between June 1, 2010 and October 31, 2012; and
- the U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Laboratory (USACIL) received the samples for analysis and inclusion in the Combined DNA Index System (CODIS).

We will request specific data for this evaluation in separate correspondence.
