

Executive Order

TRANSFERRING TO THE SERVICE AND JURISDICTION OF THE WAR AND NAVY DEPARTMENTS CERTAIN VESSELS, EQUIPMENT, STATIONS AND PERSONNEL OF THE LIGHTHOUSE SERVICE.

In accordance with the authority vested in me by the "Act making appropriations for the Naval Service for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1917, and for other purposes", approved August 29, 1916, I, WOODROW WILSON, President of the United States of America, do hereby declare that a national emergency exists and do direct that there be transferred to the service and jurisdiction of the War Department for temporary use the lighthouse tenders, including equipment and personnel thereof, as given in the following list; and that at the expiration of this service such tenders, equipment and personnel be transferred to the service and jurisdiction of the Navy Department; also, that there be transferred to the service and jurisdiction of the Navy Department the tenders, light stations and light vessel stations, equipment and personnel thereof, as given in the following list.

The Navy or War Departments shall return to the service and jurisdiction of the Department of Commerce any or all of the material or personnel of the Lighthouse Service when directed by me so to do.
