Our objective is to determine whether the Department of the Navy properly administered selected Energy Savings Performance Contracts (ESPCs) in accordance with Federal and DoD policies and procedures. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at Department of the Navy Headquarters offices, the NAVFAC Expeditionary Warfare Center, Naval Base Ventura County, California, the Naval Air Station Oceana, Virginia, and the Marine Corps Logistics Base Albany, Georgia. We may identify additional Navy or Marine Corps locations during the audit.
