

## A CASE FOR WHO WAS THE FIRST U.S. COAST GUARD C.P.O.

Coast Guard General Order 43 of 18 May 1920, is the date when the CG adopted the US Navy ratings established the present day rate of chief petty officer for the various enlisted ratings in the post World War 1 Coast Guard. It specified how Acting Warrant Officers would be made permanent CPOs and which ratings would be advanced to either CPO or Petty Officer 1<sup>st</sup> class. All these advancements were made on the same day based on time in grade in the different ratings, but no listing of seniority was established.

Who was first can be determined one way by ones position on the globe. It is strictly a function of Longitude. The further east towards the Greenwich Prime Meridian increases ones chances of being 'first'.

The Coast Guard was not as far roaming as the cutters may go today. Cutters had set coastwise patrol areas and were pretty much near shore vessels. On that day though, two cutters were at sea and well to the east of Maine.

The International Ice Patrol was established in answer to the loss of TITANIC in 1912. It was suspended during WW 1 and re-started in 1919. I found the early reports of the cutters in Bulletin #8 of the International Ice Patrol for the 1920 season. The cutters SENECA and OSSIPPEE were tasked with the patrol during the month of May, 1920

The SENECA, at noon on 18 May, was on the International Ice Patrol in approximate position 43° - 44' North ; 51° - 43' West conducting an oceanographic sounding.

The OSSIPPEE departed Portland, Maine to relieve SENECA at 1520 on 16 May 1920. Using a D.R. speed of about 8.5 knots, her position on the morning of 18 May 1920 would have been close to 43° - 05' North ; 62° - 40' West, or about 85 miles South of Halifax, Nova Scotia or 115 miles SW of Sable Island.

Known about OSSIPPEE is that records indicate that Acting Machinist William W. DeWever started a new enlistment on May 1, 1920 and reported aboard on 6 May 1920. The MUSTER ROLL for OSSIPPEE (enclosed) was prepared most likely at the end of May, but was amended and signed on June 2, 1920. No doubt this was because she had received General Order 43 on return to port. It will be noted that his rating had been changed to Chief Machinists mate vice Acting Machinist.

I have asked at the National Archives if there is any MUSTER ROLL available for SENECA during the same time frame. I have been advised that no records exist during the May timeframe.

Using the Latitude and Longitude as a basis for determining just where on the globe one was located the first advanced to Chief Petty Officer can be determined. The west coast cutters were not anywhere near the International date line.

Unless a muster list or personnel listing for SENECA can be located, I would like to propose that Chief Machinists mate William W. DeWever in cutter OSSIPPEE, while on International Ice Patrol, was the first Chief Petty Officer in the Coast Guard.

The 1915 Register of Coast Guard Officers lists William W. DeWever as Warrant Machinist in cutter ANDROSCOGGIN with an appointment date and assignment date of 7 March 1912. The Coast Guard records of cutters lists him as Machinist onboard through World War 1 and up to at least Sept 1919. The Coast Guard Bulletin for December 1946 indicates he retired on 1 October 1946 with the rank of Lieutenant Commander. I had a notation to indicate he crossed the bar in about 1955 or 56, and is buried at Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery .

The position of each of these bergs was carefully determined by observations of the sun, and it is believed that they are the ones reported by passing steamers and which could not be located by the *Seneca*. It is believed that the apparent discrepancies between the locations as reported and the locations of the bergs found is due to the difference between positions by dead reckoning and observation, as much fog had prevailed just prior to the date they were reported.

On May 15, 1920, the steamship *Winifridian*, in latitude 40° 38' N., longitude 46° 58' W., reported a surface temperature of 32° F. This report, together with 150 radio reports of surface temperatures by various vessels, leads me to believe that the Labrador Current extends well to the southward this year and that it has invaded the Gulf Stream on a line approximately as follows:

42° 37' N., 51° W.  
42° 20' N., 50° W.  
41° 53' N., 49° W.  
40° 53' N., 48° W.  
40° 30' N., 47° W.  
41° 00' N., 46° W.

On May 8, in latitude 41° 50' N., longitude 48° 50' W., the *Seneca* found the temperature of the surface water to be 38° F.

The set and drift observed between May 10 and 13, and the presence of ice as far south as 41° 10' N., seems to bear out this assumption.

The limits of observed and reported ice during the cruise were found to be as follows:

Eastern limit, 46° 24' W.  
Western limit, 50° 24' W.  
Southern limit, 41° 10' N.

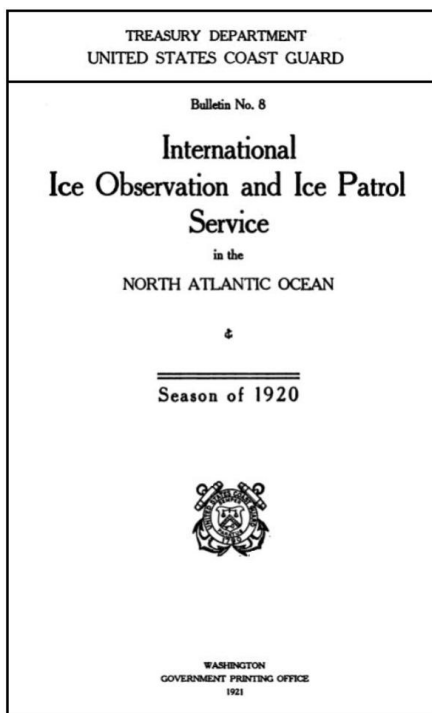
The *Seneca* was relieved by the *Ossipee* at 7 p. m., May 19, 1920, in latitude 43° 01' N., longitude 55° 46' W., in a dense fog, all ice information and instructions for ice patrol being sent on board that vessel.

During the above cruise the *Seneca* communicated with 147 vessels, received 45 ice reports and 4 obstruction reports, gave special ice information to 40 vessels, and sent out 26 broadcast warnings. Thirteen icebergs were observed during the cruise. The weather during the cruise was generally smooth, but with much fog in the steamer lane.

COAST GUARD CUTTER "OSSIPEE," LIEUT. COMMANDER T. G. CRAPSTER—FIRST CRUISE, MAY 16 TO 31, 1920.

The *Ossipee* sailed from Portland, Me., at 3.20 p. m., May 16, 1920, and relieved the *Seneca* in latitude 43° 00' N., longitude 55° 55' W., at 6.20 p. m., May 19, taking over the duties of the ice patrol. The *Seneca* was located in a dense fog by means of the radio compass, which was used constantly until she was sighted and communication effected.

During the night of the 19th intermittent fog prevailed. The *Ossipee* proceeded to the eastward in search of ice. On the 20th a course was laid to the southward and eastward, paralleling the
