#### Share Match and Lengthy Season Arbitration Agreement

This Share Match and Lengthy Season Arbitration Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between Inter-Cooperative Exchange, an Alaska cooperative corporation (the "Cooperative") and <u>Inident Sectors</u> (the "Processor") as of <u>Oct 11</u>, 2016. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Agreement shall have the meaning given them in the crab rationalization program regulations at 50 C.F.R. 680 (the "Regulations").

1. <u>Share Match</u>. Cooperative hereby agrees to deliver to Processor the crab harvested under Cooperative's 2016-2017 Class A Individual Fishing Quota issued in October 2016 or thereafter during the 2016-2017 Crab Fishing Year that is matched with Processor's 2016-2017 Individual Processing Quota issued in October 2016 or thereafter during the 2016-2017 Crab Fishing Year (the "IFQ Crab"). For the avoidance of doubt, this Agreement does not apply to 2016-2017 golden King crab Class A Individual Fishing Quota or 2016-2017 golden King crab Individual Processing Quota.

Processor agrees to accept all IFQ Crab delivered by Cooperative's members, and agrees to allocate such deliveries among Cooperative's IFQ Crab permits as Cooperative directs. Processor may not transfer its rights or obligations with respect to the IFQ Crab without first obtaining Cooperative's written consent, which Cooperative will not unreasonably withhold.

2. <u>Arbitration</u>. Cooperative and Processor hereby adopt the Lengthy Season approach to binding arbitration regarding IFQ Crab price and delivery terms. Cooperative may initiate binding arbitration on or before June 30, 2017, by providing notice to Processor at the email address below.
