SUBJECT: Followup Audit on the Army's Business Case Analysis Used to Support the Army's Transition to In-House Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Testing (Project No. D2018-D000AW-0192.000)

Our objective is to determine whether the U.S. Army Medical Command corrected problems identified in Report No. DODIG-2017-066, "Army Did Not Support Business Case Analysis Recommending Transition of Human Immunodeficiency Virus Testing," March 14, 2017. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at the Army Center for Health Care Contracting, Walter Reed Army Institute of Research, HIV Diagnostics and Reference Laboratory, and U.S. Army Medical Command. We may identify additional locations during the audit.
