7/2/2018	MWSS 371, MAG 13, 3dMAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, California, Corporal T. D. Spitzer was convicted by a military judge of violating a lawful general order and maltreatment pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reprimanded and to reduction to E-3.
7/2/2018	CLB-11, HqReg, 1st MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Corporal M. P. Tixi was convicted by a military judge of conspiracy and wrongfully selling military property. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, confinement for 24 months, a fine of \$5,000.00, and a bad conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 12 months.
7/9/2018	1stMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Private First Class C. J. Kraft was convicted by a military judge of indecent conduct pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to no punishment.
7/9/2018	SOI-W, TECOM	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Staff Sergeant J. S. Navarro was convicted by a military judge of assault pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-5 and 30 days confinement.
7/9/2018	Security Battalion, MCB Quantico	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, Sergeant J. T. Smith was convicted by a military judge of attempting to violate a lawful order and dereliction of duty pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days restriction and to reduction to E-4.
7/11/2018	MALS-26, MAG-26, 2dMAW	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Private First Class C. R. Thomas was convicted by a military judge of attempting to receive child pornography, attempted sexual abuses of a child, sexual abuses of a child by indecent communication, sexual abuses of a child by indecent conduct, extortion, and solicitation to produce child pornography. The military judge sentenced the accused to 29 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 18 months.

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7/12/2018	MALS-16, MAG-16, 3dMAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, California, Private K. J. Griffin was convicted by a military judge of unauthorized absence, wrongful use of a controlled substance, and larceny. The military judge sentenced the accused to confinement for 10 months and a bad conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 75 days.
7/12/2018	HqRegt, 2dMLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Corporal A. R. Santiagoperez was convicted by a military judge of wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
7/13/2018	HqRegt, 1stMLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Private J. D. Anderson was convicted by a military judge of failure to obey a general order or regulation, wrongful use of a controlled substance, wrongful possession of a controlled substance, indecent language, disobeying the lawful order of a commissioned officer, disobeying a non-commissioned officer, and making a false official statement pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to 13 months confinement and a bad-conduct discharge.
7/16/2018	1stMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Corporal R. A. Craig was convicted by a military judge of animal abuse and willfully damaging military property. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reprimanded.
7/17/2018	1stBn, 2dMarRegt, 2dMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Corporal J. P. Mcgrath was convicted by a military judge of sexual abuse of a child involving indecent communication pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to 67 days confinement, reduction to E-3, and a bad-conduct discharge.

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7/17/2018	H&S Bn, MCB Camp Pendleton	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Lance Corporal D. J. Rodriguez was convicted by a military judge of unauthorized absence. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 90 days.
7/18/2018	2dMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Lance Corporal R. K. Ngo was convicted by a military judge of assault consummated by a battery, abusive sexual contact, indecent recording, and false official statement. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 120 days.
7/18/2018	H&HS, MCAS Iwakuni	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Iwakuni, Japan, Sergeant J. M. Turner Jr. was convicted by a military judge of assault consummated by a battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 150 days confinement and reduction to E-1. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 90 days and any reduction below pay grade E-3.
7/19/2018	7th ESB, 1stMLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, a Sergeant was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of wrongful use of a controlled substance.
7/24/2018	5thMar, 1stMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Sergeant A. J. Morris was convicted by a military judge of failure to obey a general order, unlawful entry, larceny, wrongful use of a controlled substance, and wrongful possession of a controlled substance pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to 10 months confinement, forfeiture of two-thirds pay per month for 10 months, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.

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7/24/2018	HqRegt, 1stMLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Lance Corporal C. R. Kylus was convicted by a military judge of battery pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days restriction, 90 days of hard labor without confinement, forfeiture of \$500.00 per month for two months, and reduction to E-1.
7/25/2018	H&S Bn, SOI-W, TrngCmd	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Private First Class R. W. Begay was convicted by a military judge of involuntary manslaughter pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to 7 years confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
7/26/2018	2dBn, 4thMar, 1stMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Lance Corporal J. M. Montez was convicted by a military judge of abusive sexual contact, assault consummated by battery, and burglary pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 36 months confinement, and a dishonorable discharge.
7/26/2018	HqRegt, 2dMLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Sergeant A. C. Zachareas was convicted by a military judge of disobeying a noncommissioned officer, adultery, violation of North Carolina Statute § 14-316.1, and assault consummated by battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 395 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to defer and waive automatic forfeitures provided the forfeitures are transferred to an allotment for the benefit of the accused's dependents
7/27/2018	MWSS-371, MCAS Yuma	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, Arizona, Sergeant D. A. Aggers was convicted by a military judge of violating a lawful general order and maltreatment. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-3, 90 days hard labor without confinement, and a reprimand.

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7/27/2018	1stBn, 6thMar, 2dMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Private C. A. Stevens was convicted by a military judge of wrongful uses of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 110 days confinement and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of any time served in pretrial confinement.
7/31/2018	Combat Assault Battalion, 3dMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial in Okinawa, Japan, Lance Corporal M. S. Sanchez Jr. was convicted by a military judge of negligent homicide and willfully discharging a firearm pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1 and bad conduct discharge.
