10/3/2018	HQ Regt, 2d MLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Private First Class B. M. Fontanezburos of wrongful use and wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
10/4/2018	1st Supply Bn, CLR-15, 1st MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Corporal J. D. Lewis of sexual assault and an attempt to commit a sexual act. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, forfeiture of \$2,490 per month for 3 years, 3 years confinement, and a dishonorable discharge.
10/5/2018	MWSS-274, MAG-29, 2d MAW	At a General Court Martial at Cherry Point, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Sergeant R. C. Walker of attempted sexual abuse of a child by indecent communication and exposure, attempted receipt of child pornography, and attempted sexual assault of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 24 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.
10/5/2018	4th Civil Affairs Group, FHG, MarForRes	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant Y. E. Floresrivias of possession, viewing, and distribution of child pornography. The military judge sentenced the accused to 27 Months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
10/10/2018	1st Bn, 5th Marines, 1st MARDIV	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Private K. B. Richardson of disrespect toward a superior commissioned officer, assault and disrespect of a noncommissioned officer, escaping custody, flight from apprehension, damaging military property, assault of a law enforcement officer, assault consummated by battery, and disorderly conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to 30 months confinement and a bad conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 18 months.

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10/10/2018	Marine Corps Embassy Security Group	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Sergeant H. J. Touchet of attempting to commit a lewd act upon a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 14 months confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. In a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 6 months.
10/10/2018	3d MRB, MRR, MARSOC	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal B. H. Delnevo of conspiracy to commit larceny of military property, conspiracy to wrongfully sell military property, conspiracy to obstruct justice, larceny of military property, wrongful sale of military property, and dereliction of duty. The military judge sentenced the accused to 20 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.
10/11/2018	CLB-24, HQ Reg, 2d MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. Sanchez of attempted sexual abuse of a child by indecent exposure and communication, and attempted receipt of child pornography. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.
10/12/2018	Marine Aviation Weapons and Tactics Squadron 1, MAGTFTC, MCTEC	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, Arizona, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Sergeant M. J. Lewis of violations of lawful general orders, assault, sexual assault, and indecent viewing. The members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge.
10/13/2018	CLB-1, CLR-1, 1st MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Sergeant M. W. Faus of assault consummated by battery, child endangerment, and communicating a threat. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 5 years confinement, and a dishonorable discharge.

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10/17/2018	3d AABn, 1st MarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. C. Lin of committing lewd acts upon a child under 16, and an attempt to commit a lewd act upon a child under 16. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 18 months confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 12 months.
10/19/2018	Headquarters Squadron, MAG- 39, 3d MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Private A. MoralesCastro of violating a lawful general order, making a false official statement, wrongful possession and use of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 77 days confinement and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will disapprove all confinement.
10/19/2018	2d Bn, 1st Marines, 1st MarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. P. McKee of assault consummated by a battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1 and confinement for 6 months.
10/19/2018	1st Tanks Bn, 1st MarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. C. Plewinski of failing to go to his appointed place of duty, making false official statements, wrongful distribution of a controlled substance, and larceny. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 10 months confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.
10/25/2018	3d TSB, CLR-3, 3d MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. G. Eikelenboom of assaults consummated by battery, and a violation of a lawful general order. The military judge sentenced the accused to 8 months confinement and a bad-conduct discharge.
10/30/2018	1st LAR, 1st MarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Sergeant J. D. Schmidt of a lewd act with a child under the age 16. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 15 months confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.

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10/30/2018	5th Marines, 1st MarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Corporal B. M. Metz of arson and housebreaking. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 12 months confinement, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and a bad-conduct discharge.
