11/3/2018	1st BN, 4th MARINES 1st MARDIV	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Staff Sergeant A. X. Zamora of sexual assault and unlawful entry. The members sentenced the accused to 1 year confinement and a dishonorable discharge.
11/6/2018	CLR-17, 1st MLG	At a Special Court-Martial aboard Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. B. Carpenter, pursuant to his pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 80 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
11/8/2018	SES BN, MCI-W	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal T. Rocha of dereliction of duty, sexual assault, and indecent viewing. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 18 months confinement, total forfeitures, and a bad-conduct discharge.
11/8/2018	MCCES, TRNG CMD, MCAGCC	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, California, a military judge convicted Private First Class C. D. Dove, pursuant to his pleas, of distribution of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 93 days confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.
11/9/2018	2d Tank BN, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Corporal D. L. Webb, pursuant to his pleas, of larceny and obtaining services under false pretenses. The military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
11/13/2018	3d BN, 2d MARINES, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Private W. G. Gayle, pursuant to his pleas, of wrongful possession and wrongful introduction with intent to distribute a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement and a bad-conduct discharge.
11/14/2018	12th MCD, WRR, MCRD San Diego, CA	At a General Court-Martial at Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson, Alaska, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Staff Sergeant J. A. Hale III of wrongful use of a controlled substance, rape, assault, adultery, kidnapping, indecent language, and failure to obey a lawful general order. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, total forfeitures, confinement for 25 years, and a dishonorable discharge.

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11/14/2018	CLR-15, 1st MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. N. Walker, pursuant to his pleas, of abusive sexual contact and unlawful entry. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, 24 months confinement, and a bad conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 12 months.
11/15/2018	HQSPTBN, MCI-W	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Private J. T. McGuirk III, pursuant to his pleas, of unauthorized absence. The military judge sentenced the accused to forfeitures of 2/3 pay for six months.
11/15/2018	CLB-2, CLR-2, 2d MLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. R. Villarreal, pursuant to his pleas, of making false official statements and assault consummated by a battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 10 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
11/15/2018	3d BN, 6th MARINES, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. T. Bridges of disrespecting a superior commissioned officer. The military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days restriction, reduction to E-1, and a reprimand.
11/16/2018	2d LAR BN, 2d MARDIV	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Sergeant R. A. Edwards, pursuant to his pleas, of attempted sexual abuse of a child by indecent communication and attempted sexual assault of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 40 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 18 months.
11/16/2018	CLB-4, CLR-3, 3D MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, a panel including enlisted members convicted Staff Sergeant W. J. Scott of attempted sexual assault of a child and attempted sexual abuse of a child. The panel including enlisted members sentenced the accused to 18 months confinement, forfeiture of \$1,638.00 for 18 months, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.

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11/19/2018	9th MCD, WRR, MCRD San Diego, CA	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego, California, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant P. A. Edholm, pursuant to his pleas, of violations of lawful general orders, dereliction of duty, and adultery. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-4 and 90 days confinement.
11/19/2018	1st BN 4th MARINES 1st MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Private First Class D. D. Rosenowm, pursuant to his please, of a violation of a lawful general order, wrongful use of a controlled substance, larceny, and unlawful entry. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, a \$2,000 fine, 12 months confinement, and a bad conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of six months.
11/19/2018	VMMM-266, MAG-26, 2d MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Corporal K. J. Smith, pursuant to his pleas, of assault consummated by a battery, simple assault, and drunk and disorderly. The military judge sentenced the accused to 7 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
11/20/2018	5th MARINES, 1st MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal F. J. Gallegos, pursuant to his pleas, of unauthorized absence, and wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E- 1, 180 days confinement, and a bad conduct discharge.
11/20/2018	HQVC BN, MCRDPI	At a Special Court-Martial at Parris Island, South Carolina, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. T. Funderburk, pursuant to his pleas, of assaults consummated by battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000.00 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-1.
11/27/2018	HQBN, MCAGCC	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, California, a military judge convicted Sergeant A. M. Long, pursuant to his pleas, of assault and wrongfully carrying a concealed firearm. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1 and 6 months confinement.

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11/28/2018	CLB-8, CLR-2, 2d MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Sergeant O. A. Pepper, pursuant to his pleas, of attempted sexual abuse of a child by indecent communication, attempted receipt of child pornography, attempted sexual abuse of a child, and attempted sexual assault of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 15 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.
11/30/2018	1st BN, 10th MARINES, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Corporal V. M. Samanogarcia, pursuant to his pleas, of making a false official statement and larceny. The military judge sentenced the accused to 5 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
