We will perform the audit at Defense Health Agency, Navy Bureau of Medicine and Surgery, Air Force Surgeon General, U.S. Army Medical Command, Walter Reed National Military Hospital, Fort Belvoir Community Hospital, Brooke Army Medical Center, Madigan Army Medical Center, 59th Medical Wing Lackland Air Force Base, 75th Medical Group Hill Air Force Base, Naval Medical Center San Diego, and Naval Hospital Bremerton. We may identify additional locations during the audit.
