3/1/2018	1stBn, 12thMar, 3dMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii, Staff Sergeant J. R. Witczak was convicted by a military judge of wrongful use of a controlled substance and indecent language. The military judge sentenced the accused to 45 days confinement and reduction to E-3. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.
3/2/2018	MWHS-1, 1stMaw	At a Special Court-Martial at Okinawa, Japan, Sergeant F. Ayalacruz was convicted by a panel of officer members of dereliction of duty, assault, and disorderly conduct. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, a reprimand, and a bad-conduct discharge.
3/5/2018	HqSvcBn, MCINCR - MCBQ	At a Special Court-Martial at Quantico, Virginia, Private First Class S. Ramos was convicted by a military judge of unauthorized absence, dereliction of duty, and wrongful use of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 45 days.
3/6/2018	8th&I, MBW	At a Special Court-Martial at Quantico, Virginia, First Sergeant M. J. Brown was convicted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of abusive sexual contact and disorderly conduct. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-7.
3/6/2018	1stBn, 6thMar, 2dMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Lance Corporal T. J. Goodlin was convicted by a military judge of aggravated assault. The military judge sentenced the accused to 40 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 15 months.
3/7/2018	HqSptBn, MCIW - MCB CamPen	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Private First Class S. T. Hilton was convicted by a military judge of disobeying a lawful command, assault on a sentinel, and drunk and disorderly conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 90 days.

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3/8/2018	HMH-361, MAG-16, 3dMAW	At a General Court-Martial at Miramar, California, Lance Corporal G. Cabrera was convicted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of sexual assault. The members sentenced the accused to 7 years confinement, reduction to E-1, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and a dishonorable discharge.
3/9/2018	2dBn, 2dMar, 2dMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Lance Corporal W. A. Minchew was convicted by a military judge of wrongful use of a controlled substance, unauthorized absence, attempted viewing of child pornography, and possession of child pornography. The military judge sentenced the accused to 16 months confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 15 months.
3/12/2018	3dRTBn, RTR, MCRD PI	At a Special Court-Martial at Quantico, Virginia, Lieutenant Colonel J. Kissoon was convicted by a military judge of dereliction of duty, false official statement, and conduct unbecoming an officer and a gentleman. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reprimanded and forfeiture of \$1,000.00 pay per month for a period of 5 months. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend forfeitures for a period of 6 months.
3/13/2018	MWSS-171, MAG-12, 1stMAW	At a General Court-Martial at Iwakuni, Japan, Sergeant P. A. Laracortes was convicted by a military judge of attempted sexual abuse of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 13 months confinement, a reprimand, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 12 months.
3/14/2018	VMFA-314, MAG-11, 3dMAW	At a General Court-Martial at Miramar, California, a private was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of sexual assault.

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3/19/2018	1stLARbn, 1stMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Lance Corporal E. D. Lake was convicted by a military judge of unauthorized absence and wrongful use, distribution, and possession of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 8 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.
3/20/2018	2dSupBn, CLR-25, 2dMLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Corporal L. R. Turlington was convicted by a military judge of possessing child pornography. The military judge sentenced the accused to 20 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 18 months.
3/21/2018	HqHqRon, MCAS Iwakuni	At a Special Court-Martial at Iwakuni, Japan, Private First Class X. V. Rhodes was convicted by a military judge of assault consummated by a battery and disorderly conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days confinement, a reprimand, and reduction to E-1. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the case.
3/21/2018	MARLOGCOM	At a General Court-Martial at Parris Island, South Carolina, Corporal J. D. Colindres was convicted by a military judge for aggravated assault, obstruction of justice, negligently discharging a firearm, and conspiracy to obstruct justice. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 years confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 42 months.
3/22/2018	VMA-211, MAG-13, 3dMAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Yuma, Arizona, Lance Corporal B. W. Skaggs was convicted by a military judge of assault consummated by a battery and aggravated assault. The military judge sentenced the accused to 12 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

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3/22/2018	HQRgt, 2dMLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Lance Corporal M. D. Denham was convicted by a military judge of larceny of military property, conspiracy to wrongfully sell military property, wrongful sale of military property, and false official statement. The military judge sentenced the accused to 26 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 12 months.
3/27/2018	MASS-2, MACG-18, 1stMAW	At a General Court-Martial at Okinawa, Japan, Sergeant M. A. Neely was convicted by a military judge of attempted sexual abuse of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 3 years confinement, a reprimand, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to disapprove all forfeitures and suspend all confinement in excess of 30 months.
3/27/2018	HMLA-367, MAG-24, 1stMAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii, Lance Corporal E. M. Lawless was convicted by a military judge of larceny and unlawful entry. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement, a \$3,000.00 fine and reduction to E-1. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 45 days.
3/28/2018	3dMAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Yuma, Arizona, Lance Corporal J. R. Garner was convicted by a military judge of breach of peace, assault with a dangerous weapon, drunk and disorderly conduct, violation of a lawful order, and wrongfully discharging a firearm. The military judge sentenced the accused to 3 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.
3/28/2018	MCESG	At a General Court-Martial at Quantico, Virginia, a Sergeant was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of sexual assault.

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3/30/2018	MWCS-28, MACG-28, 2dMAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Cherry Point, North Carolina, Sergeant C. W. Raley was convicted by a military judge of wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to a \$400.00 fine, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.
3/30/2018	1stSupBn, CLR-15, 1stMLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Lance Corporal D. C. Guevara was convicted by a military judge of possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute and importation of controlled substances. The military judge sentenced the accused to 10 years confinement, a \$1,000.00 fine, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 60 months.
3/30/2018	2dBn, 10thMar, 2dMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Lance Corporal J. L. Truesdale was convicted by a military judge of wrongful use of a controlled substance, willful disobedience of a superior commissioned officer, and insubordinate conduct toward a noncommissioned officer. The military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.
