HEIDELBERG, Germany -- The Department of Defense **announced** March 16 that Col. (Promotable) Steven A. Shapiro, U.S. Army Europe's deputy chief of staff for logistics, or **G-4**, will be assigned as the Director, Materiel Enterprise Integration and Retrograde Operations Center, United States Forces-Afghanistan, Operation Enduring Freedom, in Afghanistan.
