MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Command Policy No. 2015-10-13 Civilian Access Requirements on Camp Robinson Maneuver Training Center.

1. 1. REFERENCES: AR 190-13 the Army Physical Security Program, AR NG OPORD 15-66.
2. PURPOSE: The purpose of this memorandum is to state Camp Robinson Maneuver Training Center (RMTC) command policy regarding access to the post for civilian/non-governmental personnel.
3. STATEMENT OF MILITARY NECESSITY AND PURPOSE: Recent changes to statutes dealing with possession of weapons in public areas, together with incidents involving shootings of military personnel by civilians make it necessary for Post Commanders to provide for heightened security on post. Security needs to account for force protection, protection of military and other government resources and property while providing for reasonable public access to post property for legitimate interests. Therefore, this policy allows the Post Commanders to provide the necessary level of security on this installation within the law while respecting the rights and privileges of private citizens.
4. APPLICABILITY: The provisions of this policy memorandum apply to all military personnel, civilians and state of Arkansas employees entering this post.
5. STATEMENT OF COMMAND POLICY:
 - a. Post Commanders retain authority to remove and exclude from post any person the Commander, in his or her sole discretion, deems to pose a threat to personnel, property, military operation or good order and discipline within the confines of his or her respective post.
 - b. All Contractors, Visitors and Sportsmen seeking entry to RMTC will have a background check conducted through the Arkansas Crime Information Center. All Foreign Nationals will continue to be required to pass a FBI background check in order to gain access to RMTC. The Commander may exclude or remove from post any person whose background check is not satisfactory to the Commander.
 - c. No person may enter the post who has an active warrant. Notify police and detain, if possible.
 - d. No person may operate a vehicle on the post who has a DWI in the last 12 months. If license is suspended and driver was operating vehicle, notify police, and detain, if possible.
 - e. No person may enter the post who has an un-expunged or unpardoned felony conviction class D, C or B where the date of conviction is more recent than ten (10) years from the date of entry.
 - f. No person may the enter post who has an un-expunged or unpardoned felony conviction class A or Y ever.

g. No person may enter the post who is a registered sex offender in any state, the District of Columbia or any U.S. territory or possession.

h. No person may enter the post who is convicted of a misdemeanor or a felony crime of domestic violence.

i. Identifications accepted at RMTC. All personnel entering RMTC will be prepared for his or her identification to be verified each time they enter Post. Each person needs to have their identification ready for the Security Officer when they arrive at the gate. While facial recognition is authorized, RMTC will continue to conduct periodic 100% identification checks to ensure the safety of those entering this installation. All persons who do not possess an approved form of ID must provide their Driver's License and pass for entrance. Bottom-line, if you are asked for ID . . . Show IT!!

- (m) Sportsman Pass with DL

6. VIOLATIONS: Civilians who do not meet the background check screening requirements will not be granted access to RMTC and are subject to removal and exclusion from post, up to for life, and referral to civilian authorities for arrest and prosecution as appropriate.
