(Project No. D2018-D000AU-0197.000)


We plan to begin the subject audit in August 2018. Our objective is to determine whether the Army is developing an affordable Integrated Air and Missile Defense program that can meet all capability requirements and whether these requirements remain valid and meet warfighter needs. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at the offices of the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff; the Under Secretary of Defense for Research and Engineering; the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment; the Director, Cost Assessment and Program Evaluation; the Director, Operational Test and Evaluation; the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Acquisition, Logistics, and Technology); Integrated Air and Missile Defense Project Office, Redstone Arsenal, Alabama; and the U.S. Army Fires Center of Excellence, Fort Sill, Oklahoma. We may identify additional locations during the audit.
