
SUBJECT: Evaluation of Niger Air Base 201 Military Construction (Project No. D2019-D000PT-0112.000)

Our objective is to determine whether the U.S. Air Force effectively planned, designed, and implemented Air Base 201 requirements to provide airfield and base support infrastructure. We will fully consider suggestions from management on additional or revised evaluation objectives.

The primary evaluation locations will include Headquarters U.S. Air Forces in Europe and Air Forces Africa, Ramstein Air Base, Germany, and Air Base 201, Agadez, Niger. We may identify additional locations during the evaluation. The attached request for information is for initial documents we require for review. Please provide this information in electronic format no later than **February 25, 2019**.
