1/4/2019	MarDet, Ft Leonardwood Missouri	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Private First Class G. S. Kickhaefer, pursuant to his pleas, of aggravated assault. The military judge sentenced the accused to 10 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of six months.
1/8/2019	1st Intel BN, I MIG, I MEF	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a staff sergeant was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of attempted sexual assault, sexual assault, and assault.
1/9/2019	CLR-17, 1st MLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal L. W. Johnson, pursuant to his pleas, of unlawfully selling and buying military property. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, forfeitures of 2/3 pay for six months, confinement for six months, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 120 days.
1/9/2019	VMU-1, MAG-13, 3d MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Yuma, Arizona, a military judge convicted Corporal V. A. Caballerogarcia, pursuant to his pleas, of sexual harassment and assault. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 15 days hard labor without confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.
1/10/2019	A Co, Hq Spt BN	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. L. Craver, pursuant to his pleas, of unauthorized absence. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 45 days confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.
1/17/2019	MALS-39, MAG-39, 3d MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, California, a military judge convicted Corporal D. E. Dinsmore of larceny, pursuant to his pleas. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, a fine of \$11,547.00, confinement for 12 months, and a bad-conduct discharge.

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1/17/2019	31st MEU, III MEF	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, a military judge convicted Sergeant M. D. Hamby Jr., pursuant to his pleas, of attempted rape of a child, attempted sexual abuse of a child, attempted conspiracy to commit rape of a child, and attempted conspiracy to commit sexual abuse of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 12 years confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the conveying authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 96 months.
1/18/2018	1st BN, 2d MAR REG, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Corporal R. Tyson Jr. was convicted by a military judge, pursuant to his pleas, of unauthorized absence, violation of a lawful general order, and wrongful possession of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 4 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority suspended all confinement in excess of credit given for time served.
1/24/2019	3/5, 1st MARDIV	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a staff sergeant was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of larceny.
1/25/2019	1st TSB, CLR-1 1st MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Sergeant D. Balderas, pursuant to his pleas, of assault and drunk and disorderly. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 60 days restriction, and 90 days of hard labor.
1/30/2019	CLR-17, 1st MLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Private C. A. Harper, pursuant to his pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 40 days confinement and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend the bad-conduct discharge for six months.
1/30/2019	7th MAR REG, MCAGCC	At a Special Court-Martial at Twenty-nine Palms, California, a staff sergeant was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of wrongful use of a controlled substance.

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1/31/2019	7th ESB, 1st MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a lance corporal was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of false official statement, sexual assault, and obstruction of justice.
1/31/2019	4th MCD, ERR	At a Special Court-Martial at Parris Island, South Carolina, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant S. K. Mitchell, pursuant to his pleas, of larceny, violations of a lawful general order, and false official statements. The military judge sentenced the accused to 220 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
