Department of Defense Combating Trafficking in Persons Office



DEC 2002



National Security Presidential Directive-22, states, "The United States hereby adopts a 'zero tolerance' policy regarding United States Government employees and contractor personnel representing the United States abroad who engage in trafficking in persons."

July 2003



The Department of Defense Office of the Inspector General publishes Korea assessment report.

Dec 2003



The Department of Defense Office of the Inspector General publishes Bosnia/Kosovo assessment report.

Jan 2004



The Deputy Secretary of Defense (DSD) issues a policy outlining specific objectives, including anti-trafficking education requirements, for all Service members and DoD civilians.

Sep 2004



The Secretary of Defense issues a policy endorsing the January 2004 DSD Memo adding emphasis on labor trafficking.

2005



Release of the Combating Trafficking in Persons (CTIP) General Awareness training.

Oct 2005



President Bush signs Executive Order 13387, "2005 Amendment to the Manual for Courts-Martial," adding an offense, "Patronizing a Prostitute."

Oct 2006



DoD issues an interim rule amending the Defense Federal Acquisition Regulation Supplement to implement DoD policy prohibiting activities on the part of DoD contractors and contractor employees that support or promote trafficking in persons.

Feb 2007



Publication of Department of Defense Instruction (DoDI) 2200.01, "Combating Trafficking in Persons (CTIP)."

Dec 2008



Release of CTIP Law Enforcement training.

Feb 2009



Publication of Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Subpart 22.17, "Combating Trafficking in Persons" and FAR Clause 52.222-50, "Combating Trafficking in Persons."

2010



Launch of CTIP website - <https://ctip.defense.gov/>

Sep 2010



Update DoDI 2200.01, "Combating Trafficking in Persons (CTIP)."

May 2012



Establish the CTIP multidisciplinary Task Force to implement a Strategic Plan.

Sep 2012



President Obama issues Executive Order 13627, "Strengthening Protections Against Trafficking In Persons In Federal Contracts."

May 2014



Establish the CTIP Strategic Plan 2014-2018 with partnering, policy, training, monitoring, and enforcement goals.

Oct 2014



Release of CTIP Contracting and Acquisition Professionals training.

2016



The Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) develops an anti-trafficking technology tool called "Memex" and receives the 2016 Presidential Award for Extraordinary Efforts to Combat Trafficking in Persons.

Sep 2018



Launch of Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) CTIP training for DoDEA school personnel.
