12/3/2018	2d BN, 10th Mar Regt, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal B. N. Mack Jr., pursuant to his pleas, of introduction with intent to distribute and wrongful use of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 180 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will disapprove all confinement.
12/4/2018	2d BN, 10th Mar Regt, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Corporal W. Vasquez, pursuant to his pleas, of introduction with intent to distribute. The military judge sentenced the accused to 135 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 4 months.
12/10/2018	2d TSB, CLR-2, 2d MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal B. J. Henderson, pursuant to his pleas, of possessing child pornography. The military judge sentenced the accused to 25 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 24 months.
12/11/2018	3d BN, 6th Mar Regt, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Private A. T. Gough, pursuant to his pleas, of larceny and violation of a lawful general order. The military judge sentenced the accused to 135 days confinement and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 120 days.
12/12/2018	MACS-2, MACG-28, 2d MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Cherry Point, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Corporal E. M. Brasberger, pursuant to his pleas, of failure to obey lawful general order, damaging military property through neglect, being drunk on duty, and assaulting a person in the execution of law enforcement duties. The military judge sentenced the accused to 4 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 90 days.

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12/12/2018	1st Supply BN, CLR-15, 1st MLG	At a General Court-Martial aboard Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Corporal S. N. Muldrow, pursuant to his pleas, of conspiracy to commit larceny and larceny. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, a fine of \$10,000, 18 months confinement, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 12 months.
12/12/2018	MCCES, MCAGCC	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, California, a military judge convicted Private First Class N. J. Diaz, pursuant to his pleas, of the wrongful use and wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 120 days confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.
12/14/2018	MAG 41, 4th MAW	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Support Facility, a panel of officer members convicted Major W. E. Hernandez, contrary to his pleas, of violating general regulations, obstruction of justice, and conduct unbecoming of an officer and gentleman. The members sentenced the accused to 18 months confinement and a \$5000 fine.
12/14/2018	HQ Regt, 3d MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Corporal J. E. Araujo Jr., contrary to his pleas, of sexual assault and violation of a lawful general regulation. The panel of members sentenced the accused to 6 years confinement, forfeiture of \$1,630.00 for 72 months, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.
12/14/2018	CLR-27, 2d MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a panel of officer and enlisted members acquitted a corporal of sexual assaults, aggravated assaults, and assaults consummated by battery.
12/18/2018	H&S BN, SOI-E, TECOM	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Private First Class C. A. Boggs, pursuant to his pleas, of wrongful use of controlled substances and unauthorized absence. The military judge sentenced the accused to 14 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will disapprove the punitive discharge.

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12/19/2018	MACS-2, MACG-28, 2d MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. M. Victrelli, pursuant to his pleas, of damaging military property through negligence, reckless operation of a vehicle, being drunk on duty, and wrongful appropriation. The military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
12/19/2018	2d Tank BN, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal N. C. Lautenschlager, pursuant to his pleas, of wrongful use and distribution of controlled substances and willful disobedience of superior commissioned officer. The military judge sentenced the accused to 5 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 4 months and defer and waive automatic forfeitures.
12/19/2018	1st MarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Lance Corporal J. Quezada, contrary to his pleas, of violating a lawful general order, false official statement, sexual assault, and abusive sexual contact. The panel sentenced the accused to 6 years confinement and a dishonorable discharge.
12/19/2018	MCCES, MCAGCC	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. P. Nguyen, pursuant to his pleas, of wrongful distribution and wrongful introduction of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 11 months confinement, a fine of \$5,000, and a bad-conduct discharge.
12/20/2018	MWWS-272, MAG-26, 2d MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant L. V. Tilley, pursuant to his pleas, of false official statements. The military judge sentenced the accused to a reduction to E-6 and a written letter of reprimand.

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12/20/2018	H&S BN	At a Special Court-Martial at Parris Island, South Carolina, a panel of officers and enlisted members convicted Sergeant E. R. Alegria, contrary to his pleas, of wrongful possession and distribution of a controlled substance, false official statements, and conspiracy to possess controlled substances. The members sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement, forfeiture of \$546.00 per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.
