The Compendium summarizes recommendations the DoD OIG issued to DoD components that remained open as of March 31, 2019.

1,581

Open Recommendations

There were **1,581** open recommendations issued to **48** DoD components in **319** DoD OIG reports.

1,481

Corrective Actions

DoD management agreed to take corrective actions on **1,481** of the **1,581** recommendations.

Potentially \$4.8 Billion in Savings

If DoD components implemented all **41** open recommendations with significant monetary benefits, the DoD could save **\$4.8 billion**.

Open recommendations that DoD OIG and DoD components *have not* agreed on an acceptable corrective action.

Open recommendations that are at least **5** years old.

Open recommendations that warrant priority attention.
