5/31/2019	2d LE Bn, 2d MIG, II MEF	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Corporal D. R. Huntington, consistent with his pleas, of conspiracy, housebreaking, and larceny of military property. The military judge sentenced the accused to 4 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
6/4/2019	2d Bn, 7th Mar Regt, 1st MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, California, a military judge convicted Sergeant E. A. Rosete of violating lawful general orders, an assault consummated by battery, and drunk and disorderly conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to a reduction to E-1, forfeiture of \$1,100.00 per month for six months, and 3 months confinement.
6/5/2019	5th Mar Regt, 1st MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Private D. J. Fasanella, consistent with his pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to forfeiture of \$1,120.00 per month for 11 months and 11 months confinement. Pursuant to a plea agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 90 days and disapprove the adjudged forfeiture.
6/5/2019	HMLA-367, MAG-24, 1st MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, a military judge convicted Corporal D. C. Powers, consistent with his pleas, of wrongful use of controlled substances, wrongful distribution of a controlled substance, wrongful introduction of controlled substances, and obstructing justice. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, to forfeiture of \$1,100/month for 8 months, 8 months confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 60 days.
6/6/2019	H&S Bn, MCIEAST	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a panel of officer members convicted Lance Corporal D. D. Keeling of violation of a lawful general order. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-2 and a reprimand.

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6/7/2019	CLR-17, 1st MLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a panel including enlisted members convicted Staff Sergeant M. D. Williams of violation of a lawful general orders, assault consummated by a battery, and indecent language. The military judge sentenced the accused to a reduction to E-3 and 18 days confinement.
6/11/2019	8th Comm Bn, 2d MIG, II MEF	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. T. Dowdy, consistent with his pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer and wrongful use of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 146 days confinement and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will disapprove all confinement in excess of 142 days.
6/12/2019	HMLA-469, MAG-39 3d MAW	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal M. J. Day, consistent with his pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance and assault. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 7 months confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.
6/12/2019	2d TSB, CLR 2, 2d MLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge acquitted a lance corporal of wrongful use of a controlled substance.
6/12/2019	MCIS, TECOM	At a Special Court-Martial at Quantico, Virginia, a military judge convicted Private M. W. Andersen, consistent with his pleas, of larceny and unlawful entry. The military judge sentenced the accused to four months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,120.60 per month for four months, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will disapprove all of the adjudged confinement.

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6/13/2019	1st Bn, 8th Mar Regt, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. M. Gonzalez, consistent with his pleas, of violation of a lawful general order, assault consummated by battery, communicating a threat, obstructing justice, and wrongful use of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to confinement for 180 days, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to the pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 120 days.
6/17/2019	VMFA-323, MAG-11, 3d MAW	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, California, a military judge convicted Corporal M. R. Terwilliger, consistent with his pleas, of wrongful use of a controlled substance, conspiracy, and attempted distribution of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 24 months confinement and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the convening authority will suspend all confinement in excess of 13 months.
6/17/2019	31st MEU, III MEF	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. L. Goodrich, consistent with his pleas, of assault consummated by a battery and the lesser included offense of battery. Consistent with a plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 12 months confinement, forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
6/19/2019	4th ANGLICO, FHG, MARFORRES	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, South Carolina, a panel including enlisted members convicted Master Sergeant L. F. Chambers of conspiracy, larceny, and the transfer of stolen property. The members sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 2 years confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.
6/20/2019	2d Sup Bn, CLR 25, 2d MLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge acquitted a staff sergeant of use of a schedule controlled substance.

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6/20/2019	VMA-311, MAG-13, 3d MAW	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, California, a military judge convicted Sergeant C. A. Zazueta, consistent with his pleas, of violating a lawful general order, false official statement, misappropriation, battery, obstructing justice, and extramarital sexual misconduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to a reduction to E-1, six months confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.
6/20/2019	HMLA-367, MAG-24, 1st MAW	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, a military judge convicted Corporal N. F. Martin-Moore, consistent with his pleas, of possessing child pornography, indecent conduct, and adultery. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, 5 months confinement, and a bad-conduct discharge.
6/21/2019	5th Mar Reg, 1st MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Staff Sergeant A. C. Bailey of unlawful entry. The members sentenced the accused to 30 days restriction.
6/25/2019	HMLA-167, MAG-29, 2d MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant B. L. Roberts, consistent with his pleas, of larceny and obstructing justice. The military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days confinement, a \$500 fine, and reduction to E-3. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will suspended all confinement.
6/26/2019	3d Bn, 2d Mar Regt, 2d MARDIV	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Private First Class K. R. Janeau, consistent with his pleas, of assault consummated by a battery and violating a lawful general order. The military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days confinement and a reduction to E-1.
6/26/2019	9th MCD, WRR	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, California, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. M. Tryan, consistent with his pleas, of violating a lawful general order and making a false official statement. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-3.

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6/27/2019	I MIG, I MEF	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Corporal P. L. Gregory, consistent with his pleas, of violating a lawful general order and assault consummated by a battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to a reduction to E-2 and 30 days restriction.
6/27/2019	MAG-29, 2d MAW	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Corporal N. G. Wagner, consistent with his pleas, of possessing receiving, viewing, and distributing child pornography. The military judge sentenced the accused to 24 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority will suspended all confinement in excess of 12 months.
6/27/2019	2d CEB, 2d MARDIV	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Sergeant T. J. Glosser, consistent with his pleas, of larceny of military property. The military judge sentenced the accused to 20 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
