1/4/2018	9thESBn, 3dMLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Okinawa, Japan, Corporal J. X. Mella was convicted by a military judge of assault and assault consummated by a battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 120 days confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000.00 pay per month for a period of 6 months, a reprimand, and reduction to E-1. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 60 days.
1/4/2018	2dBn, 4thMar, 5thMar Reg, 1stMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Lance Corporal M. F. Currington was convicted by a military judge of violation of a lawful general order, possession and use of a controlled substance, and sexual abuse of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 36 months confinement and a dishonorable discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.
1/5/2018	III MEF	At a Special Court-Martial at Okinawa, Japan, Master Gunnery Sergeant A. W. Ross was convicted by a military judge of false official statement and larceny. The military judge sentenced the accused to a reprimand and reduction to E-8. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.
1/5/2018	HqSvcBn, MARFORPAC	At a Special Court-Martial at Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii, Corporal J. P. Smith was convicted by a military judge of wrongful use and possession of controlled substances and assault consummated by a battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 60 days.
1/5/2018	1stBn, 11th Mar, 1stMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Lance Corporal B. J. Morton was convicted by a military judge of possession and distribution of child pornography. The military judge sentenced the accused to 4 years confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 18 months.

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1/8/2018	HqSptBn, 1stMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Lance Corporal A. M. Carrion was convicted by a military judge of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer, assault consummated by a battery, communicating a threat, and disorderly conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to 12 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
1/8/2018	1stBn, 8thMar, 2dMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Lance Corporal A. F. Pierce was convicted by a military judge of larceny, mail stealing, bank fraud, aggravated identity theft, and false official statement. The military judge sentenced the accused to 77 months confinement, a \$15,000.00 fine, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 18 months.
1/9/2018	WWBn-W, WWR	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Gunnery Sergeant S. D. Faulkner was convicted by a military judge of disobeying a lawful order, assault on a child under the age of 16, and drunk and disorderly conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to 89 days confinement and reduction to E-5. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.
1/9/2018	HqSptBn, 1stMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Lance Corporal J. S. Norman was convicted by a military judge of wrongful introduction with intent to distribute and wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 3 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.
1/10/2018	MWSS-271, MAG- 14, 2dMAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Cherry Point, North Carolina, Corporal C. M. Hernandez was convicted by a military judge of assault consummated by a battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

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1/10/2018	HqBn, 2dMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Sergeant J. W. Foulke was convicted by a military judge of wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 20 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 6 months.
1/11/2018	MCIA, TrngCmd	At a General Court-Martial at Quantico, Virginia, a staff sergeant was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of sexual assault and assault consummated by a battery.
1/11/2018	HqSptBn, MCIWest - MCB CamPen	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Sergeant E. M. Portillo was convicted by a military judge of soliciting another to commit an offense. The military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-4.
1/12/2018	1stBn, 3dMar, 3dMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Kaneohe Bay, Hawaii, a corporal was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of violation of a lawful general order and assault consummated by a battery.
1/13/2018	2dIntelBn, II MEF	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Sergeant K. R. Robinson was convicted by a military judge of disrespect toward noncommissioned officer, failure to go to appointed place of duty, and damaging non-military property. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement, forfeitures of \$1092.20 pay per month for a period of six months, and reduction to E-1.
1/16/2018	HqSptBn, MCIWest - MCB CamPen	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Corporal J. A. Dingman was convicted by a military judge of unauthorized absence. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 90 days.
1/16/2018	1stBn, 10thMar, 2dMarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Private First Class A. M. Jones was convicted by a military judge of fleeing apprehension, wrongful appropriation, assault consummated by a battery, and reckless operation of a vehicle. The military judge sentenced the accused to 120 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

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1/17/2018	HqBtry, 10thMar, 2dMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Corporal R. E. Quiroa was convicted by a military judge of wrongful use and distribution of a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 20 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 12 months.
1/18/2018	HqBn, 3dMarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Okinawa, Japan, Private First Class T. M. Pearcy was convicted by a military judge of sexual abuse of a child, possession of child pornography, solicitation, and indecent conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to 10 years confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, a reprimand, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 30 months.
1/19/2018	CLR-35, 3dMLG	At a General Court-Martial at Okinawa, Japan, Lance Corporal J. N. Mebes was convicted by a military judge of sexual abuse of a child, solicitation, and possession of child pornography. The military judge sentenced the accused to 8 years confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, a reprimand, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 30 months.
1/22/2018	IMHG, I MEF	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Pendleton, California, Chief Warrant Officer 5 E. DeLeon Jr. was convicted by a military judge of possession and distribution of child pornography and indecent language. The military judge sentenced the accused to 7 years confinement and a dismissal. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 60 months.
1/24/2018	MRSg, MARSOC	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, Gunnery Sergeant L. G. Hunter was convicted by a military judge of larceny, leaving his place of duty, and presenting a false claim. The military judge sentenced the accused to 12 months confinement, a \$12,000.00 fine, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

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1/25/2018	HMX-1, MCINCR-MCBQ	At a General Court-Martial at Quantico, Virginia, Sergeant J. R. Inoa-Jovine was convicted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of adultery.
1/25/2018	HqRgt, 3dMLG	At a General Court-Martial at Okinawa, Japan, Lance Corporal S. R. Turner was convicted by a military judge of attempting to distribute a controlled substance, wrongful possession with intent to distribute and use of a controlled substance, soliciting another to commit an offense, and conspiracy to export and introduce a controlled substance. The military judge sentenced the accused to 3 years confinement, total forfeitures of all pay and allowances, a \$1,000.00 fine, a reprimand, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 24 months.
1/25/2018	MCLB Albany	At a Special Court-Martial at Parris Island, South Carolina, Private C. N. McCloud was convicted by a military judge for conspiracy to obstruct justice, assault consummated by a battery, reckless operation of a vehicle, violation of a lawful orders, and accessory after the fact. The military judge sentenced the accused to 10 months confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000.00 for 10 months, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspended all confinement in excess of 8 months.
1/26/2018	III MEF	At a General Court-Martial at Okinawa, Japan, Lance Corporal K. M. Yang was convicted by a military judge of attempted sexual abuse of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 24 months confinement, total forfeitures of all pay and allowances, a reprimand, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 15 months.

Stellato was convicted by a military judge of aggravated assault with a loaded firearm and reckless endangerment. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 years confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge. The pre-trial agreement had no effect on the sentence.

RodriguezBolanos was convicted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of false official statement. The members sentenced the accused to forfeiture of \$500.00 pay per month for a period of 2 months and reduction to E-2.

Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 4 months.

Pursuant to a pre-trial agreement, the convening authority agreed to suspend all confinement in excess of 30 months.
