This 50-year-old man was found deceased on the beach after the crab boat he was working on capsized.

HPI: The decedent was part of a 3 man crew aboard a crabbing vessel returning to port. Conditions were reported rough, and the boat capsized while trying to pass through the jaws entering Yaquina Bay. 1 crew member was picked up from the ocean and transported to the emergency room, and one was reported missing and presumed deceased trapped in the wreckage. The body of the decedent was found by Newport Fire personnel washed up by Nye Beach, and he was pronounced dead by medics at the scene. The body was released to the funeral home for examination.

Review of systems: Reported well prior to the trip.

Past medical history: Not available.

Allergies: Not available.

Medications: None reported.

Family history: Not contributory.

Social history: Not available.

Physical exam: Revealed the unclothed, very tall, well muscled and well-developed body of an adult male with long gray hair, mustache, and extensive tattoos. The body was sandy and damp, but showed no signs of extensive submersion with no evident maceration of digits. A complete review of the body revealed scattered very small superficial abrasions on the face and extremities. The vault, face, neck, torso, abdomen and extremities showed no significant injury.

Labs: Fluids for toxicology drawn and sent

Course of events: Investigation into the event is ongoing by Coast Guard and Oregon State police.

This 48 -year-old man was transported from the ocean to the emergency room after the crab boat he was working on capsized. Resuscitation attempts failed.

HPI: The decedent was part of a 3 man crew aboard a crabbing vessel returning to port. Conditions were reported rough, and the boat capsized while trying to pass through the jaws entering Yaquina Bay. 1 crew member was found by Newport Fire personnel washed up by Nye Beach, and one was reported missing and presumed deceased trapped in the wreckage. This man was located in the ocean by Coast Guard helicopter, unresponsive, and taken to the emergency room in Newport . He was reported hypothermic at 30.6 degrees, with fixed and dilated pupils, gurgling respiration noises with ventilation and unresponsive. Resuscitation attempts failed and the man was declared dead. The body was released to the funeral home for examination.

Review of systems: unavailable

Past medical history: Not available.

Allergies: Not available.

Medications: None reported.

Family history: Not contributory.

Social history: Not available.

Physical exam: Revealed the unclothed, tall, well muscled and well-developed body of an adult male with long brown hair, mustache and beard, 2 tattoos. The body was sandy and damp, but showed no signs of extensive submersion with no evident maceration of digits. Resuscitation equipment was still in place, including ET tube and defibrillation pads. An IV catheter insertion site was identified in the right antecubital fossa. A complete review of the body revealed scattered very small superficial abrasions on the face and extremities. The vault, face, neck, torso, abdomen and extremities showed no significant injury.

Labs: Fluids for toxicology drawn and sent

Course of events: Investigation into the event is ongoing by Coast Guard and Oregon State police.

Assessment: Death by drowning. Chest wall trauma was postulated by the Emergency Room physician but no visible or palpable evidence of significant antemortem injury was identified.

This 48 -year-old man was transported from the ocean to the emergency room after the crab boat he was working on capsized. Resuscitation attempts failed.

HPI: The decedent was part of a 3 man crew aboard a crabbing vessel returning to port. Conditions were reported rough, and the boat capsized while trying to pass through the jaws entering Yaquina Bay. 1 crew member was found by Newport Fire personnel washed up by Nye Beach, and one was picked up by helicopter in the ocean and taken to the Emergency Room where he was later declared dead. This man was found in the wheelhouse of the capsized ship, deceased. The body was removed and released to the funeral home for examination.

Medications: None reported.

Family history: Not contributory.

Social history: Not available.

Physical exam: revealed the well nourished and well muscled body of an older adult male, unclothed for my examination. A ring on the right 4th finger and watch on left wrist were removed by the Funeral Home, there was a small silver colored metal ring in the left earlobe. Both forearms were tattooed. A superficial scalp laceration without underlying skull injury or swelling/bruising was noted with a small amount of adjacent bleeding. There was no significant injury or trauma to the chest, abdomen or extremities and the scalp laceration was compatible with post mortem injury.
