SUBJECT: Research on Military Construction Requirements and Efforts for Increasing Installation Resiliency (Project No. D2019-D000PT-0123.000)

We plan to begin the subject research immediately. The objective of the research project is to gather and analyze data, make inquiries, and conduct general research for potential evaluation projects related to DoD facilities engineering efforts aimed at increasing installation resiliency and operational viability—particularly in response to severe weather events and climate effects.

We will contact senior officials, managers, and subject matter experts at the offices of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Energy, Installations, and Environment; the Naval Facilities Engineering Command; the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers; and the U.S. Air Force Civil Engineer Center. We will solicit their input regarding any efforts that may be underway to improve building codes and standards and construction designs and methods for increased resiliency. We will also solicit their views on issues that may warrant future oversight coverage. We may arrange visits to Tyndall Air Force Base, Florida; Marine Corps Air Station New River, North Carolina; and other organizations or installations through established points of contact. No reports will be issued from this research effort.

Please provide us with a point of contact for this research project within **5 days** of the date of this memorandum. The point of contact should be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay band equivalent, or the military equivalent.
