Lt. Colin Fogarty currently serves as a Field Judge Advocate in the Thirteenth District Legal Office located in Seattle, Washington. He assists with operational law, military justice, and legal assistance.

Prior to this assignment, Lt. Fogarty served as the Incident Management Chief at Coast Guard Sector Upper Mississippi River from 2011-2014. His responsibilities included directing oil spill and pollution recovery efforts, responding to floods, and serving as a Boarding Officer. From 2009-2011 Lt. Fogarty served as the Weapons Officer aboard CGC MOHAWK (WMEC-913). His tour of duty included patrols in Central America, South America, the Caribbean, and West Africa.

Lt. Fogarty graduated from The United States Coast Guard Academy in 2009, with a Bachelor's of Science in Government. He received a Juris Doctor from Washington University in Saint Louis in 2016. Lt. Fogarty is a member of the Missouri Bar.

Lt. Fogarty's military awards include the Army Commendation Medal, two Coast Guard Achievement Medals, and Humanitarian Service Medal.
