SUBJECT: Evaluation of Medical Resources and Guidance to Trainers at Recruit Training Centers in the DoD (Project No. D2020-DEV0PA-0007.000)

We plan to begin the subject evaluation immediately. Our objective is to determine the capability and accessibility of medical resources available for recruits at DoD recruit training centers and review the guidance provided to trainers on the use of these medical resources. We will also review all recruit deaths that occurred during the recruit training process from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2019.

We will conduct site visits to recruit training centers in the DoD. We will also interview personnel from the education and training commands, the medical departments of the military services, the Defense Health Agency, and the U.S. Military Entrance Processing Command. Depending on the need for further information for the evaluation, we may expand our site visits to other organizations.

Please provide us with a point of contact for the evaluation within **5 duty days** of the date of this memorandum. The point of contact must be a Government employee—a GS-15, pay-band equivalent or the military equivalent.
