8/6/2019	CNATT	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant K. M. Kaszinski, consistent with his pleas, of battery, communicating a threat, and willful discharge of a firearm under circumstances to endanger human life. The military judge sentenced the accused to 10 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
8/6/2019	MALS-14 MAG-14 2d MAW	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant B. S. Thomas of an unauthorized absence. The military judge sentenced the accused to forfeitures of \$500.00 a month for one month and a reprimand.
8/7/2019	HMLA-367 MAG-24 1st MAW	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, Okinawa, Japan, a military judge convicted Corporal C. N. Pullara, consistent with his pleas, of an attempt, and possession, control, and distribution of LSD. The military judge sentenced the accused to one year and one day confinement, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.
8/9/2019	2d Med Bn 2d MLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a corporal was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of use of a controlled substance.
8/12/2019	2d MarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Sergeant A. P. Krasovec, consistent with his pleas, of larceny of military property. The military judge sentenced the accused to 14 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 10 months will be suspended.
8/13/2019	HQ Bn MCB Hawaii	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Sergeant D. L. Hall of contempt or disrespect towards a noncommissioned or petty officer. The military judge sentenced the accused to be reprimanded.

8/16/2019	1st Bn 10th Mar Regt 2d MarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a panel of officer and enlisted members convicted Corporal D. N. Ward of willful disobedience of a noncommissioned or petty officer, contempt or disrespect towards a noncommissioned or petty officer, and violation of a lawful general order. The members sentenced the accused to forfeiture of \$600.00 pay per month for a period of 1 month, and a written reprimand.
8/16/2019	2d Tank Bn 2d MarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant G. A. Hopper, consistent with his plea, of attempted sexual abuse of a child. The military judge sentenced the accused to 18 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 9 months will be suspended.
8/21/2019	CLR 27, 2d MLG	At a Special Court-Martial at Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a sergeant was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of disrespect towards superior commissioned officer.
8/22/2019	3d Bn 12th Mar Regt 3d MarDiv	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Smedley D. Butler, Okinawa, Japan, a sergeant was acquitted by a military judge of sexual assault.
8/22/2019	HQ Bn MCB Hawaii	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. R. Lettieri, consistent with his pleas, of flight from apprehension, wanton operation of a vehicle, and willful disobedience of a noncommissioned officer. The military judge sentenced the accused to 10 days restriction and reduction to E-1. Pursuant to a plea agreement, the maximum restriction that could be adjudged was 10 days.
8/22/2019	9th Comm Bn I MIG I MEF	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal A. A. Ranola, consistent with his pleas, of a violation of a lawful general order, possession of marijuana, distribution of marijuana, use of marijuana, and introduction of marijuana. The military judge sentenced the accused to 84 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and to forfeit \$250.00 per month for 2 months. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement the forfeitures will be disapproved.

8/23/2019	1st Bn 1st Mar Regt 1st MarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal C. R. Carmack, consistent with his pleas, of battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 5 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
8/23/2019	2d MLG	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a sergeant was acquitted by a panel of officer and enlisted members of aggravated sexual contact with a child, sexual abuse of a child, rape of a child, sexual assault of a child, and attempted sexual abuse of a child.
8/27/2019	1st Rad Bn I MIG I MEF	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. B. Brewer, consistent with his pleas, of battery. The military judge sentenced him to 5 months confinement and reduction to E-1. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of 30 days will be suspended.
8/28/2019	3d MAW	At a General Court-Martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, California, a military judge convicted Corporal D. A. Denheart, consistent with his pleas, of battery. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
8/30/2019	1st MarDiv	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California, a military judge convicted Private K. B. Richardson, pursuant to his pleas, of larceny. The military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months confinement and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, the punitive discharge will be disapproved and all confinement in excess of 30 days will be disapproved.
8/30/2019	MCCSSS TRNG CMD	At a Special Court-Martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, a military judge convicted Private First Class J. J. Eisenmann, consistent with his pleas, of Larceny, Obtaining services under false pretenses, and knowingly using a credit or debit card without authorization. The military judge sentenced the accused to 12 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge. Pursuant to a pretrial agreement, all confinement in excess of time already served will be suspended.
