The DEPARTMENT OF STATE has not yet received reply as to whether the PRESIDENT accepts the new plan which was communicated to the AMERICAN MINISTER and much time might be saved if, as soon as this is approved, you would communicate it to me directly. If I am informed to that effect today I can call a meeting of the BANKERS for day after tomorrow. In respect to the text of my authorization, they can send me one at once which contains the substance of the text which I communicated by cable Saturday night, and if in the meeting the BANKERS should request higher powers or specific authorization, my credentials could be made more full afterwards but we would already have held the conference and made much progress. If quoting the legislative act which authorizes the Government in this case offers any difficulty for the moment, send the text without the quotation although it is preferable that the text of my credentials granting full powers contain it.
