on 51 Meters. Would send call several times then send approximately 15 code groups, then he would stop and send QRK. Then he would wait a moment and send OK. He would ~~xxx~~ then repeat the call and send more code groups. Code ~~xxx~~ he sends is unintelligible, characters are unlike any continental code groups. Code. Speed about 25 per minute but would not copy due to strange characters must be Japanese code. Worked all night and signed off at 5 am -

February 13/14 . 2.00 am:

JPS v JPP same procedure as yesterday signed off at 5 am  
JRRC on abt 39 meters testing antenna current, not working anyone.  
JYZJ v JFAB on abt 48 meters, sending QRL

station unknown QRA. abt 47 - 48 meters:  
10 letter code groups. Copy attached. audibility ~~25~~ R5  
DC note marked commutator ripple. signed off at app 5.45 am  
Apparently sending blind and to automatic receiver, as he makes his own corrections and repeats without stops.

February 15/16 4.00 am:

same unknown station as night of 13/14 . Can be distinguished by the DC note with the commutator ripple and characteristic sending. Approximately 100 code groups attached.

February 16/17

: Only Australian and Canadian, South American and U S stations heard.-
