We plan to begin the subject audit in April 2020. The objective of this audit is to determine whether the DoD transports arms, ammunition, and explosives by sea in accordance with DoD Regulations. We may revise the objective as the audit proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at the Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois; the Military Sealift Command, Norfolk, Virginia; the Military Ocean Terminal Sunny Point, North Carolina; and the Military Ocean Terminal Concord, California. We may identify additional locations, including locations in geographic combatant command areas of operation during the audit.
