MEMORANDUM FOR DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Evaluation of the DoD's Actions to Control Contamination from Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) at DoD Installations
(Project No. D2020-DEV0SR-0088.000)

We plan to begin the congressionally requested evaluation in February 2020. The objective of this evaluation is to determine the extent that the DoD has taken steps to: identify, mitigate, and remediate contamination from Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) at DoD installations; and identify and inform populations exposed to PFAS at DoD installations of the associated health and safety concerns. We may revise the objective as the evaluation proceeds, and we will also consider suggestions from management for additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the evaluation at the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment, the Under Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness, DoD Components, and Defense agency office locations. For planning purposes, we anticipate holding our entrance conference on February 18, 2020, and conducting site visits during April and May 2020.
