CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT MICHAEL P. BUGAY

Chief Master Sergeant Michael P. Bugay is the command chief for the 116th Air Control Wing, Robins Air Force Base, Georgia and two geographically separated units. Chief Bugay advises the wing commander on all matters affecting mission readiness, training, effective utilization, health of the force and professional development of 1,400 enlisted members assigned to the 116 ACW and associated GSUs. Chief Bugay began his military service in the United States Marine Corp from 1980 to 1992 as a Weapons System Specialist on the A6E Intruder aircraft. During this time, Chief Bugay participated in Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm, where he planned and coordinated combat flying operations in support of national and coalition interests in Kuwait. After a small break in service, he returned to military service in 1998 by enlisting into the United States Air Force Reserve, serving with the 920th Maintenance Squadron. In 1999, Chief Bugay transferred to the Georgia Air National Guard as a Munitions Maintenance and Storage Craftsman on the B-1B aircraft. In 2002, the 116th Bomb Wing transitioned to the E-8C Joint STARS, as the Air Force's first Total Force Initiative Wing, and was re-designated the 116th Air Control Wing. Chief Bugay has served as superintendent in the 116th Maintenance Operations Squadron and 116th Mission Support Group. He has deployed in support of Operations Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, New Dawn and Odyssey Dawn.
