COL Brian C. Bolio, a New England native, commissioned in 1995 as a second lieutenant in Army aviation upon graduation from the United States Military Academy at West Point.

COL Bolio's aviation assignments include company/troop commands with 6th Cavalry Regiment in Korea; 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment at Fort Carson, Colorado; 10th Aviation Regiment at Fort Drum, N.Y.; and battalion S-3 operations officer for 4th General Support Aviation Battalion at Fort Hood, Texas. He deployed to Afghanistan with 10th Mountain Division as an assault company commander in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, and in 2008 he became a Functional Area 40 space operations officer.

Space functional area highlights include joint experience as the executive officer for the Air Land Sea Application Center, S-3 for the 1st Space Brigade, Third Army G-31 Special Operations chief, and deputy chief of staff, G-3 at U.S. Army Central Command. COL Bolio was recently assigned as the senior executive officer to the chief of Space Operations, United States Space Force, and commander, United States Space Command.

COL Bolio's professional military education includes Aviation Officer Basic and Advance Courses, the United States Army Command and General Staff College and the Air War College. He holds masters' degrees in leadership, management and strategic studies along with a bachelor's degree in environmental science.
