The Compendium summarizes recommendations the DoD OIG issued to DoD components that remained open as of March 31, 2020.

# 1,602

## Open Recommendations

There were **1,602** open recommendations issued to **48** DoD components in **311** DoD OIG reports.

# 1,446

## Corrective Actions

DoD management agreed to take corrective actions on **1,446** of the **1,602** recommendations.

## Potentially \$6.5 Billion in Savings

If DoD components implemented all **51** open recommendations with significant monetary benefits, the DoD could potentially save **\$6.5 billion**.

Open recommendations that DoD OIG and DoD components *have not* agreed on an acceptable corrective action.

# 170

Open recommendations that are at least **5** years old.

# 35

Open recommendations that warrant priority attention.
