SUBJECT: Research on DoD Law Enforcement Organizations' Responses to Active Shooter and  
Workplace Violence Incidents (Project No. D2020-DEV0SV-0154.000)

The Office of Inspector General is researching the DoD law enforcement organizations' response to active shooter and workplace violence incidents. This research project will collect policy and guidance documents, training documents, response plans, and a list of previous active shooter and workplace violence investigations from USD(I&S), each of the military service's law enforcement organizations, and military criminal investigative organizations to further define the scope of a potential future evaluation. We will consider suggestions for research from management within the scope of the objectives.

Our research will include speaking with senior officials and managers from USD (I&S), the military services' law enforcement organizations, military criminal investigative organizations, and the Pentagon Force Protection Agency. The research will also include reviews of directives, instructions, regulations, manuals, training requirements, training standards, and closed law enforcement investigations related to active shooter and workplace violence incidents from the period of January 1, 2009 to July 15, 2020.

Please provide us with points of contact for the research project by July 31, 2020. Points of contact should be knowledgeable of the law enforcement organization's processes and information management systems used to document the law enforcement response to active shooter and workplace violence incidents.
