The first nine of the planned 58 Sentinel Class FPC's have been commissioned as this is written in mid May 2014. So far all are being built by Bollinger SY, which has built all of the small cutters constructed for the Coast Guard since the 1980's. All of these have been built based on existing designs from other sources with modifications to meet the needs of the Coast Guard. The FPC's are based upon the Damen Stan Patrol 4708 design. The major modification to this design adds a stern ramp for launching and recovering a small boat.






