Additional questions for the Base Access granting authority to consider:

- 1. If you had symptoms stated above or those consistent with COVID-19, have you been to a doctor? Did the doctor diagnose you with something other than COVID-19?
- 2. Have you had any contact with others confirmed with COVID-19 virus in last 14 days?
- 3. Have you been tested for COVID-19 and received negative results?
- 4. Have you been in large gathering areas (e.g., shopping center, grocery store, off-base gymnasium, etc.) in the last 14 days?
 - a. What specifically did you do away from home?
 - b. Were these trips limited to minimal duration to only obtain necessary fuel, food, medical and other supplies as allowed by local state directives and/or CDC guidelines?
 - c. Were you able to apply social distancing (6-foot minimum spacing) during the entirety of the visit?
 - d. Did you thoroughly wash or sanitize your hands after the visit?
- 5. If just traveling through a "hot spot" area in the last 14 days, what was your route of travel and did you stop in those areas? If you stopped over in a "hot spot" area, how long were you there and what did you do?

- 6. Do you have of any other extenuating circumstances in your personal life that may present additional COVID-19 risk factors that could affect you or your families? For example, high risk employee, any underlying medical concerns, employee provides routine care for elderly or other at-risk family members.
- 7. Do you have of any other extenuating circumstances that elevate the risk of exposing other employees at AEDC to COVID-19? For example, you have routine direct contact with family members who work in elevated risk fields such as medical, first responder, emergency, etc.
