2 Oct 20	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class E. J. Dorsey, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy, making a false official statement, introduction of a controlled substance, distribution of a controlled substance, and wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 21 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
2 Oct 20	TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private Q. S. L. Chamblee, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiracy, battery, and aggravated assault by strangulation or suffocation. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 12 months of confinement and a bad conduct discharge.
3 Oct 20	1stCEB, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members convicted Corporal D. A. White of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer and extramarital sexual conduct. The members sentenced the accused to 60 days of restriction with hard labor, a reprimand, and reduction to E-2.
5 Oct 20	2dBn, 3dMarReg, 3dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. Horta, pursuant to the accused's plea, of assault consummated by a battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 3 months of confinement and reduction to E-1.
5 Oct 20	MWSS-372, MAG-39, 3dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant R. S. Espinosa of willfully disobeying a noncommissioned officer. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 15 days of confinement and reduction to E-3.
5 Oct 20	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal B. M. Fincher, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by a battery upon a child. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 13 months of confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
7 Oct 20	8thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
8 Oct 20	CNSWGWP	At a special court-martial at Command Fleet Activities Yokosuka, a military judge convicted Lieutenant Commander C. G. Sims, of failure to obey an other lawful order and prevention of authorized

		seizure of property. The military judge did not impose punishment.
8 Oct 20	CLB-31, 31stMEU	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Foster, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
9 Oct 20	2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant C. A. McKaye, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-6.
15 Oct 20	III MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Foster, a military judge convicted Private First Class C. N. Hurt, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of assault consummated by a battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 4 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 per month for 4 months, and reduction to E-1.
15 Oct 20	4th MAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Sergeant L. O. Silva, pursuant to the accused's plea, of making a false official statement. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge did not impose punishment.
16 Oct 20	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
17 Oct 20	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members convicted Sergeant D. K. Kunishige of sexual abuse of a child, rape of a child under 12 years of age, sexual assault of a child between 12 and 16 years of age, receipt, possession, and viewing child pornography, soliciting another to produce and distribute child pornography, failure to obey a lawful order, obstructing justice, and adultery. The members sentenced the accused to 30 years of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, reduction to E-1, and a dishonorable discharge.
19 Oct 20	H&S Bn, MCB Camp Pendleton	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal T. J. Howell, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of fleeing apprehension, willful destruction of military property, drunk driving, misappropriation of military property, and unlawful entry. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 43 days of confinement, a \$2,800 fine, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
21 Oct 20	1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.

22 Oct 20	8thMarReg, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
22 Oct 20	HqBn, MCB Hawaii	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Master Sergeant F. R. Duran, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer and accessing a government computer to obtain protected information for an unauthorized purpose. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-6.
23 Oct 20	3dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. A. Howard, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual abuse of a child. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 36 months of confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
23 Oct 20	TrngCmd	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Corporal D. C. Robertson, pursuant to the accused's plea, of child endangerment. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 4 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
28 Oct 20	SecBn, MCB Quantico	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. E. Green, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of making a false official statement and indecent language. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 2 years of confinement and reduction to E-1.
29 Oct 20	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a panel of members convicted Private J. A. Figueroa of violation of a lawful general order, wrongful use of a controlled substance, communicating threats, abusive sexual contact, assault consummated by battery, and drunk and disorderly conduct. The military judge sentenced the accused to 13 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and a bad conduct discharge.
29 Oct 20	1stMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a panel of members convicted Lance Corporal E. N. Vance of attempted extramarital sexual conduct, attempted sexual assault of a child, and attempted sexual abuse of a child. The members sentenced the accused to 15 months of confinement, a dishonorable discharge, and reduction to E-1
30 Oct 20	MCRD Parris Island	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant E. R. Shields, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of attempted indecent recording, wrongful use of a controlled substance, indecent exposure, indecent recording, and viewing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement,

		the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-1, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, 52 months of confinement, and a dishonorable discharge.
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
