

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DRUG TEST BATTERY	<p>LACK OF CONVERGENCE (LOC)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eyeglasses may remain on, if worn. • I am going to check your eyes. Hold your head still and follow the stimulus with your eyes, only. I will be moving the stimulus around in a circle and towards the tip of your nose. I will not actually touch your nose. If your eyes feel like they are going to gross naturally, let them cross. Do you understand? (Response) • Position stimulus 12-15" in front of the subject's nose. Begin by moving the stimulus in a circle in front of the subject's face. 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DRUG TEST BATTERY	<p>MODIFIED ROMBERG BALANCE TEST</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please stand with your feet together and your arms down at the sides, like this. (Demonstrate placement of both feet and placement of arms at sides) • Stay in this position and do not start to perform the test until I tell you to do so. Do you understand the instructions so far? (Response) • When I tell you to start, tilt your head back approximately 45 degrees and close your eyes. (Demonstrate without closing your eyes) • While doing this you will estimate the passing of 30 seconds. When you think exactly 30 seconds has gone by, you will put your head down and say stop. Do you understand? (Response) • Begin.
