

Marine Corps General and Special Court-Martial Dispositions August 2020		
Date	Unit	Description
8/7/2020	1stMarDiv	At a special court martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Gunnery Sergeant A. A. Camacho, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order, wrongful drug use, drug distribution, and introduction of drugs onto a military installation with the intent to distribute. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 4 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 per month for 4 months, and reduction to E-1.
8/7/2020	MarForCom	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, a panel of members convicted Private First Class C. N. Evans of rape, disorderly conduct, and wrongful drug use. The members sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge and 5 years of confinement.
8/10/2020	1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal J. GarciaCruz, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery and extramarital sexual conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 10 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,155 per month for 10 months, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
8/11/2020	CLR-4, 4TH MLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
8/12/2020	Training Command	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant G. CerdanSuarez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of forgery, solicitation of another to commit an offense, maltreatment, making a false official statement, and extramarital sexual conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 per month for 2 months, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
8/14/2020	2dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a panel of members convicted Cpl J. C. Brown of making a false official statement. The members sentenced the accused to forfeiture of \$1,151 per month for 2 months, reduction to E-3, 90 days of hard labor, and a reprimand.

8/18/2020	2dMAW	At a general court martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal J. E. Lebron, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of communicating a threat, larceny, unauthorized absence, and signing a false document. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 17 months of confinement, reduction to E-1, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and a bad conduct discharge.
8/19/2020	Training Command	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal K. K. Nakapaahu, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful drug use and drug distribution. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 5 months of confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
8/20/2020	HqBn, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Seamen M. P. Lanier, U.S. Navy, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongfully accessing a government computer to obtain protected information and assault consummated by battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 100 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
8/20/2020	1st MLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal J. A. Westphal, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order and reckless endangerment. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 18 months of confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
8/21/2020	H&SBN, MCIPAC	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Private First Class B. L. NunezBermudez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 4 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,155 pay per month for 4 months, and reduction to E-1.
8/21/2020	CLR-17, 1stMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant J. D. Marchio, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of damaging non-military property and assault consummated by a battery on a spouse. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 per month for 6 months, reduction to E-1, and a reprimand.

8/27/2020	HQBN, MCAGCC	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Private First Class A. J. Palominos, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating lawful general orders and drunk driving. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$800 per month for 4 months, restriction with hard labor for 60 days, and reduction to E-1.
8/28/2020	CLB-3, CLR-3, 3D MLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant N. B. McDonald, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order, willful dereliction of duty, assault consummated by battery, extramarital sexual conduct, and larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 19 months of confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
8/28/2020	2dMAW	At a special court martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Corporal D. Q. Martinez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of aggravated assault and disorderly conduct. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 6 months of confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
8/31/2020	2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal W. J. Cancel, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violation of a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 154 days of confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad conduct discharge.
