1 Mar 21 1	SOI-W	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal L. Andrade, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny, wrongful appropriation, and unlawful entry. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-1.
2 Mar 21 2	MWSS-372, MAG-39, 3dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal R. R. Adams, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order, wrongful use of controlled substances, and the wrongful introduction of controlled substances with the intent to distribute. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 11 months and 29 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,000 pay per month for 12 months, and reduction to E-1.
2 Mar 21 3	2dRadBn, II MIG, II MEF	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant S. N. Ali, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer and violating a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to reduction to E-5, 90 days of hard labor without confinement, and a reprimand.
2 Mar 21 4	9thESB, 3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
3 Mar 21 5	2dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Private First Class E. Ramirez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of the wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
4 Mar 21 6	I MEF	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. J. Floyd, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of making a false official statement and indecent recording. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.
4 Mar 21 7	9thESB, 3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.

5 Mar 21 8	9thESB, 3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant E. R. Roberts, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery upon a spouse and unauthorized absence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 3 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,582 pay per month for 3 months, and reduction to E-3.
5 Mar 21 9	2dAABn, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal L. A. Yarberry, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and possession of a controlled substance and violating a lawful general order. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
9 Mar 21 10	TrngCmd	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Quantico, a military judge acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
10 Mar 21 11	MALS-29, MAG-29, 2d MAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Private First Class B. S. Guayara, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery and unlawful entry. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 10 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
11 Mar 21 12	2dMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal T. E. Crabb, pursuant to accused's pleas, of attempted larceny, willful disobedience of a noncommissioned officer, aggravated assault with a dangerous weapon, and larceny. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
12 Mar 21 13	3dMAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal R. D. Davis, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of battery. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 12 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
12 Mar 21 14	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Private First Class R. A. Corps, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of conspiring to wrongfully distribute a controlled substance and wrongful use, distribution, and introduction of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 18 months of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.

15 Mar 21 15	3dMLG	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Corporal M. A. True, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of sexual abuse of a child, sexual assault of a child, and domestic violence. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 16 years of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
16 Mar 21 16	2dCEBn, 2dMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, a military judge convicted Corporal C. E. Ovandovelasquez, pursuant to the accused's plea, of wrongful distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 116 days of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
17 Mar 21 17	1stBn, 4thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal D. B. Marschinke, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use, possession, and distribution of controlled substances. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 6 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
18 Mar 21 18	MTACS-38, MACG-38, 3dMAW	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Miramar, a military judge convicted Staff Sergeant M. S. Gregory, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of extortion. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 90 days of confinement, and reduction to E-2.
22 Mar 21 19	9thESB, 3dMLG	At a special court martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Butler, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal B. L. Grubb, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful possession and distribution of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 8 months of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,190 pay per month for 8 months, and reduction to E-1.
22 Mar 21 20	2d MAW	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal K. C. Holben, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of production and receipt of child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a dishonorable discharge, 2 years of confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and reduction to E-1.

24 Mar 21 21	CLB-3, CLR-3, 3dMLG	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal S. C. Nance, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of violating a lawful general order and wrongful use of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 30 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$892 pay per month for 1 month, and reduction to E-1.
25 Mar 21 22	HQBn, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Corporal D. G. Colorado, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of misappropriation and unlawful entry. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 150 days of confinement, forfeiture of \$1,170 pay per month for 6 months, and reduction to E-1.
30 Mar 21 23	HqSvcBn, MCRD San Diego	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego, a military judge convicted Hospitalman Second Class E. M. Borja, U.S. Navy, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of indecent recordings and broadcasting indecent recordings. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to a bad conduct discharge, 7 months of confinement, and reduction to E-1.
30 Mar 21 24	2ndBn, 7thMarReg, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Twentynine Palms, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal G. A. Wubker, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and possession of a controlled substance. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 60 days of confinement and reduction to E-1.
