Reference No. 1561[a]. There was no [B' formal] basis for issuing "DUNYA"[ii] with a Soviet passport. However, the "MISTRESS[KHOZYAJKA]"[i] agreed to issue one and DUNYA agreed to accept it

DUNYA, however, already had a Swedish passport which had just been issued. She visited the Soviet passport and the Swedes [C' did not demand anything]
