As a man he is correct, honest, irascible. In politics he plays no part. A typical official. He does not enjoy special respect in BOGOTA circles. He speaks favourably of the USSR. Has left-wing tendencies, especially recently. The announcement in the Press of his marriage to a Soviet citizen, Maria SPMENOVA was in general favourably received in local circles, but was regarded slightly ironically.
