for HOLLTWOOD on September 20th. As there is no

evidence in the traffic to the contrary, it is assumed was still on the fest Coast and was

still known under this cover-name a year later.

[111] KAY :

Probably Stepan Zakharovich APRESTAN, Soviet Vice-Consul

in SAN FRANCISCO since March 1945.

[iv] KARL:

Presumably who appears in the

NE7 YORK Lane under this cover-name.
