ALERT IN EASTERN NAVAL DISTRICT RELAYED 23 NOVEMBER

As a result of the death of President Kennedy, the Eastern Naval District of Cuba was placed on an alert at [EXEMPT] 23 November by [EXEMPT] headquarters for that district. ((A)) [EXEMPT]

[EXEMPT] On 23 November, the alert was relaxed a certain degree by [EXEMPT] instructions were issued to [EXEMPT] a subordinate, to give leave to 25 percent of their personnel for the 22nd and 24th and that further orders would be forthcoming on 25 November 1963.

The instructions to grant leave to personnel is an indication that the alert is being relaxed and the note that further instructions would be issued on 25 November indicates that a relaxation of the alert is planned for the district by Cuban Naval authorities in the Eastern Naval District.
