AT 0709 062, ONE OF THE GROUND STATIONS STATED DUCTE ONE ACET PARACHUTING ALPEADY ... ONE ACET IS PARACHUTING THERE...OME ACFT HAS FALLEN. THE GROUND STATIONS, ONE OF WHICH PROBABLY LOCATED NEAR DONG ANH, CONTINUED TO MAKE PEFERENCES TO HOSTILE ACET FLYING NORTH AND WEST OF THE MELD. AT 0717Z. THE AFLO CONTROLLER AT PHUC YEN QUERIED AS TO WHETHER THE FOSTILE AS DOWNED BY A MISSILE OR BY BULLETS. ANOTHER CONTROLLER REPLIED THAT THE HOSTILE HAD BEEN DOWNED BY BULLETS AND THAT HE HAD SIGHTED A READ AND WHITE PARACHUTE SETTLING AT THE EAST END. THE GROUND STATIONS CONTINUED TO COSFRVE HOSTILE ACFT. IDENTIFIED AS F4H'S AND F-195'S, ACTIVE OVER DONG ANH, TAM GIANG (UNICCATED) AND IN THE VICINITY OF PHUC YEN. THE GROUND STATION ALSO STATED THAT THE HOSTILES CARRIED LARGE ROCKETS. TAT C717Z, A GROUND STATION STATED THAT FOUR F-4'S AND FOUR F-185'S HAD ENTERED DONG ANH. HE THEN STATED THAT HE ONLY SAW THREE OF THE F-105'S LEAVE AND THAT THE F-4'S WERE STILL IN THE AREA. SHORTLY AFTER \$718Z, A GROUND STATION STATED THAT HE HAD SIGHTED ONE OF THE POSTILES ON FIRE AND FALLING, HOWEVER HE LATER INDICATED THAT THEY WERE F-4'S DROPPING BOMBS AND THAT NONE ACTUALLY FELL. AT 97232, A GROUND STATION MADE A REFERENCE TO THE -DOWNED ACET WHEN HE SAID THAT IT HAD FALLEN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO DONG ANH AREA. RETHEEN 0726Z AND 0731Z, SEVERAL REFERCES TO HOSTILE ACFT WERE MADE BY THE GROUND STATIONS DURING WHICH TIME TWO COMBAT READY MIGS WERE PLACED ON STRIP ALERT.

AT 0731Z, THE TOEWER CONTROLLER AT PHUC YEN QUERIED

DRY TACTICAL VOICE COMES INTERCEPTED RETHERN 83057

ONE F-105 DOWNED BY GROUND FIRE IN VICINITY OF DONG ANH DRV TACTICAL VOICE COMMS INTERCEPTED BETWEEN Ø705Z AND Ø734Z ON Ø4 SEP 55 REVEALED THE SHOOTDOWN OF GNE F-105 NEAR DONG ANH [2]07N 10558F).

REGINNING AT 87867, CONVERSATION RETWEEN TWO GROUND STATIONS INDICATED THAT TWO F-185'S WERE DIVING ON THE RUNWAY (PROBABLY AT PHUC YEN). THE HOSTILES THEN MAGE A RIGHT TURN. AT 8788 REZ. ONE OF THE GROUND STATIONS STATED OUTTO ONE ACFT PARACHUTING ALPEADY... ONE ACFT IS PARACHUTING THERE... ONE ACFT HAS FALLEN. THE GROUND STATIONS. ONE OF WHICH PROBABLY LOCATED NEAR DONG ANH, CONTINUED TO MAKE PEFERENCES TO HOSTILE ACFT FLYING NORTH AND WEST OF THE AFLD.

AT 8718Z. THE AFLD CONTROLLER AT PHUC YEN QUERIED AS TO WHETHER THE POSTILE AS DOWNED BY A MISSILE OR BY BULLETS. ANOTHER CONTROLLER REPLIED THAT THE HOSTILE HAD BEEN DOWNED BY BULLETS AND THAT HE HAD SIGHTED A READ AND WHITE PARACHUTE SETTLING AT THE EAST END. THE GROUND STATIONS CONTINUED TO OBSERVE HOSTILE ACFT. IDEATIFIED AS FAH'S AND F-185'S, ACTIVE OVER DONG ANH. TAM GIANG (UNICCATED) AND IN THE VICINITY OF PHUC YEN. SHORTLY AFTER 07182. A GROUND STATION STATED THAT HE HAD SIGHTED ONE OF THE HOSTILES ON FIRE AND FALLING. HOWEVER HE LATER INDICATED THAT THEY WERE F-4'S DROPPING BOMBS AND THAT NONE ACTUALLY FELL.

AT 07232. A GREUND STATION MADE A REFERENCE TO THE DOWNED ACET WHEN HE SAID THAT IT HAD FALLEN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO DONG ANH AREA.

RETWEEN M726Z AND M731Z. SEVERAL REFENCES TO HOSTILE ACET WERE MADE BY THE GROUND STATIONS DURING WHICH TIME TWO COMBAT READY MIGS WERE PLACED ON STRIP ALERT.

AT 0731Z, THE TOEWER CONTROLLER AT PHUC YEN CLERIED AM UNDENTLETED GROUND STATION AS TO THE NAME OF THE AMERICAN PIRATE THAT HAD BAILED OUT, HOWEVER HE WAS NOT ANSWERED. AT 07327, A GROUND STATION AGAIN MADE A REFERENCE TO THE COWNEC PILOT AND THE MILITARY
