THIS WAS THE LAST PREVIOUSLY NOTED ACTIVITYINVOLVING THIS AIRFIELD. REPEATED U.S. STRIKES ON THISAIRFIELD CAUSED IT TO REMAIN UNSERVICEABLE FOR SOME TIME.ON 25 JULY, PHOTOGRAPHY INCICATED THAT THE RUNHAY ATHOA LAC WAS AGAIN SERVICEABLE AND REVEALED THO DISMANTLEDMIG-15/17'S AND TWO DUMMY MIG-21 AIRCRAFT ON THE AIRFIELD.THE INITIAL SIGINT REFLECTION OF THIS AIRFIELD AGAINBEING OPERATIONAL WAS NOTED ON 30 JULY. ON THIS DATE, DRYFLIGHT SERVICE FACILITIES SCHEDULED ONE FLIGHT OF FOURMIG-17'S FOR LOCAL FLIGHT ACTIVITY OUT OF HOA LAC, ANDONE FLIGHT OF FOUR MIG-17'S TO CONDUCT AN INTER-AIRFIELDFLIGHT FROM HOA LAC TO HANOI GIA LAM. FLIGHT ACTIVITYMAS SCHEDULED FOR BETWEEN 30/220Z AND 31/1130Z JULY.ON 30 JULY, BETWEEN 2250Z AND SCHEDULED FOR BETWEEN 38/2288Z AND 31/1138Z JULY. ON 38 JULY, BETWEEN 2258Z AND 2328Z, FOUR HANOI GIALAM-BASED MIG-17'S PERFORMED AIR/ATTACK PRACTICE EXERCISESIN THE VICINITY OF HOA LAC AIRFIELD. WHEN INITIALLYREFLECTED, THESE MIGS WERE ALREADY AIRBORNE AND BEINGCONTROLLED BY THE HOA LAC TOWER CONTROLLER. AT THECOMPLETION OF THE MISSION, THE MIGS LANDED AT HOA LAC.ALTHOUGH THESE MIGS WERE NOT REFLECTED TAKING-OFF, IT IS BELIEVED THEY ORIGINATED FROM HANDI GIA LAM, PERFORMEDTHEIR EXERCISE, AND THEN LANDED AT HOA LAC. ON 31 JULY, BETWEEN \$230Z AND \$253Z, APPROXIMATELY THREE HOURS AFTERTHEIR LANDING AT HOA LAC, THESE SAE FOUR PILOTS RETURNEDTO HANOI GIA LAM. THE ABOVE ACTIVITY INDICATES THAT ALTHOUGH HOA LACAIRFIELD DOES NOT PRESENTLY HOUSE ANY OPERATIONAL MIGAIRCRAFT, IT IS CAPABLE OF SUSTAINING AT LEAST LIMITED MIGOPERATIONS AND MAY BECOME FULLY OPERATIONAL IN THE HEARFUTURE.
